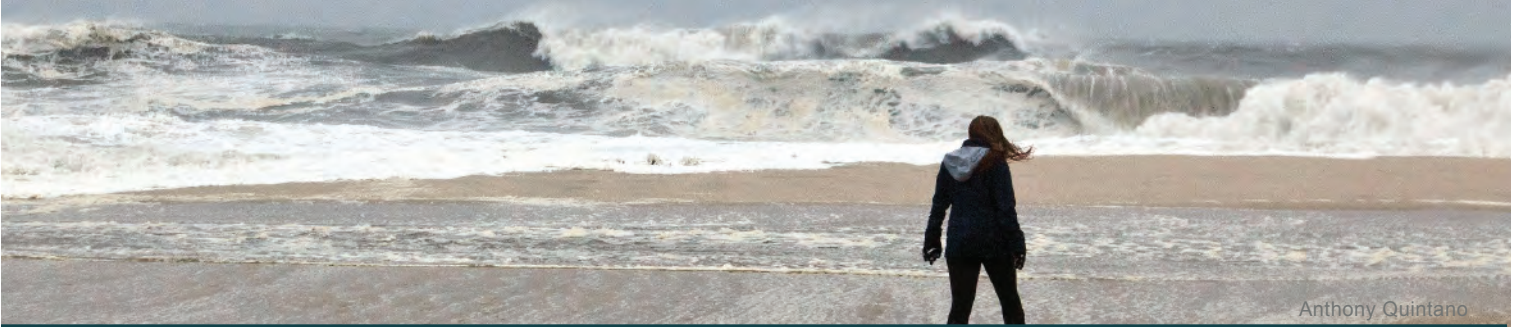


FOCUS GROUP STUDY SEEKS PARTICIPANTS MONMOUTH & OCEAN COUNTY RESIDENTS
