NORTHERN REGION:

To Date:

- Total cubic yards of debris removed (inland): 9,197
- Total number of large debris recovered: 39 vessels
- Total verified sediment removal (total cubic yards): 116,041
- Total verified acres surveyed by side-scan sonar: 32,438
- Estimated hydrographic survey acres: 212

This Week's Operations:

- All debris removal operations completed as of 12/31/13.
- Site cleanup operations completed as of 1/10/14.

CENTRAL REGION:

To Date:

- Total cubic yards of debris removed (inland): 78,460
- Total number of large debris recovered: 114 vessels/vehicles
- Total verified sediment removal (total cubic yards): 327,429
- Total verified acres surveyed by side-scan sonar: 54,248
- Estimated hydrographic survey acres: 494

- Completed final hydrographic surveys of Zone 4, Areas 3 and 4.
